Trail Passes:

Trail passes are included with entry fee. A pass list of registered racers will be provided to Mt. Bachelor Nordic Center after registration closes. Coaches and skiers registered for two days of racing will pick up a complimentary pass for course inspection Friday.

USSS Licensed Coaches who have a coaching bib will receive a trail pass for Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

There is no discount this year for Family members/spectators who attend the races. A regular day ticket will need to be purchased at the Nordic Lodge or online. Adults are \$30, \$22 for youths, teens, and seniors, and free for kids under 5.

Race volunteers receive a pass for trail access and an additional pass to be redeemed for helping. Please contact Nordic Director Dylan Watts for volunteering opportunities for the weekend.

All racers, spectators and volunteers must be on skis well on the trail network. With the exception of the team tent area next to the stadium, and volunteers working stadium jobs. Walking on the trails is not allowed. Snowshoe access to the race course is possible, but also requires a trail pass.

Hotel:

The Waypoint Hotel (1415 NE 3rd St, Bend OR 97703) is the official hotel of the race. Call [(541) 382-7011, contact@waypointhotel.com and make sure you mention you are coming to an MBSEF event.

Registration:

- **Bib pick up for teams and individuals will be distributed at the TCM Friday evening.**
- **Unpicked up bibs will be at the Start Area from 7:30 - 8:15 both days.**
- Racers will keep their bibs after the Saturday race and use the same bibs on Sunday. Bibs will be collected after the Sunday race.
- Racers only racing Saturday should turn in their race bibs at the finish Saturday.

Start List:

The start lists will be posted Friday after the coaches meeting online at www.webscorer.com . The posted start list will represent any changes made at the coaches meeting to the seeding, group order, etc. Any start list posted or circulated prior to that will be considered Drafts.

Results:

Unofficial results will be posted at Webscorer.com. Results will be posted and updated periodically through the day.

Awards:

Awards to the top 3 finishers in each NRL scored age group will be given at the conclusion of each race at the venue.

Course Inspection:

Courses will be signed Friday AM. Beware of two way skiing as the race courses are open skiing Friday, as well as the Saturday and Sunday courses sharing sections of trail but running in opposite directions.

Registration

Please Note! There are two registration sites depending on which part of the event you wish to register for. There is a US Ski and Snowboard National Ranking List event for USSS members , and a community event open to any racer! (Any level US Ski and Snowboard member can race in the US Ski and Snowboard race, a competitor membership is needed to earn National Ranking List points and is a must if you are looking to qualify for the Junior National Championships in March.) Registration is entirely online.

Registration Closes at 11:59 PM on Wednesday December 14. There will be no late registration.

Registration for US Ski and Snowboard National Ranking List Event \$40, U16+, and U14 to be scored to USSS NRL ranking list or racing up.

Registration is via [USSS signup](#). To register, racers need to:

- 1) log into my.usskiandsnowboard.org
- 2) on the tools section of their personal dashboard, click on "Athlete Event Registration"
- 3) on the event search page put in the proper criteria (sport, pacific northwest, age class, gender, etc.) and click "Search Competitions" The Bend JNQ event code is 35598

Waxing Restrictions and Recommendations

Per PNSA rules all skiers agree to use a non-fluorinated glide wax which will be announced by the race organizer:

The glide wax for the race will be decided by 10AM 12/14/22 and communicated to participating clubs and individuals.
